TRAVELING SOLO

While traveling solo, there are a few factors you may want to take into account including transportation and being in Portland.

Transportation

Portland International Airport (PDX) is the closest airport and approximately 30-45 minutes from downtown.

Once in Portland, there are multiple ways to get around. The airport's central location offers easy access to the public bus, shuttles, and light rail service, and both convenient and affordable ground transportation options are available for
